**ORDER REGARDING RESPONSE TO
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Re: Dkt. No. 19

The court has reviewed Defendants Chun-Hui Miao and Bian-Wang.com's response to the court's March 13, 2018 Order to Show Cause, and Plaintiff Dongxiao Yue's response thereto. [Docket Nos. 19, 22.] As the court previously noted, the complaint names two separate defendants, Miao and the website Bian-Wang.com. Compl. ¶ 5. The court understands Defendants' March 21, 2018 submission to mean that Defendant Bian-Wang.com is a sole proprietorship that has no separate legal identity from Defendant Miao, and that a judgment against Bian-Wang.com would be a judgment against Miao himself. By no later than March 28, 2018, Defendants shall submit a declaration under penalty of perjury attesting to those facts. Defendants shall also make clear in the declaration whether or not Miao's March 2, 2018 consent to Magistrate Judge Jurisdiction (Docket No. 10) is also submitted on behalf of Bian-Wang.com.
